**ARTICLE I  
NAME AND HEADQUARTERS  
OF THE CLUB**

**Section 1.**

The name of this organization, incorporated under the laws of the State of Illinois on February 3, 1969, shall be the Edsel Owners Club, Inc., hereafter referred to as the "Club". The Club Headquarters shall be located in the city in which the Vice President of Membership shall reside. In addition, the Club shall retain Arenzville, Illinois 62611-9603 as a permanent address for the Edsel Owners Club, Inc. as per the Incorporation Laws of Illinois.

**ARTICLE II  
OBJECT OF THE CLUB**

**Section 1.**

The purpose of the Club shall be the unification of a friendly group to help in the restoration and preservation of the Edsel automobile, model years 1958, 1959 and 1960, manufactured by the Ford Motor Company.

**Section 2.**

Ownership of an Edsel shall not be a requisite for Regular Membership in the Club, and any person interested in the object may become a Regular Member.

**Section 3.**

The Club may sponsor a young peoples group in order to promote a continuing interest among its teenagers or young people.

**Section 4.**

The Club may sponsor other clubs which are composed of members of the Club in good standing.

**ARTICLE III  
MEMBERSHIP IN THE CLUB**

**Section 1.**

Any person interested in the named models of the Edsel automobile may, upon payment of necessary dues become a Regular Member of the Club. One Associate Member per household may pay annual dues and have all Club rights and privileges with the exception of receiving publications.

**Section 2.**

Regular Members and Associate Members owning Edsel automobiles shall attempt to attend the Annual Convention, bringing with them their cars if in safe running order.

**Section 3.**

A Regular Member is the dues paying person in a household. There may be more than one (1) Regular Member per household. Each Regular Member must pay the necessary dues to become a Regular Member of the Club.

**Section 4.**

Associate Members shall be either members of a family or a companion over the age of 16 residing in the same household as the Regular Member. If one Associate Member per household so wishes, they may pay an annual dues of \$15.00 per year and have all Club rights and privileges with the exception of receiving publications.

**Section 5.**

Regular Members must attain an age of 16 years in order to cast a vote at the Annual Convention.

**Section 6.**

1. Life Members shall be the Founders of the Club. They shall serve on the Board of directors with a vote.
